Letter from the State Deputy

Brother Knights,

Last month I warned that although we made a huge difference in preventing action on HB 2330 (the bill requiring insurance coverage of abortions in Washington State) there is still a risk of action because of the extended legislative session. Well, that risk is becoming a reality because of intense pressure from Planned Parenthood and NARAL on state senators, likely to cause the senate to take the bill to the floor for action once the budget has been passed – likely this Thursday, April 5.

Thanks to your efforts, we have about an even chance of defeating this attack on the Culture of Life – but only if our legislators remain stalwart in the face of intense pressure. We need to contact our state senators once again – even if already done a few months ago – to reinforce our message. Personal contacts are always best, but in this case phone calls can be very helpful too, particularly in areas where the senator is not firm in his/her stance.

In case you get an opportunity for an extended dialogue on this topic, there are a few key reasons why the senators should be urged to vote against this bill (in addition to our obvious concerns over the protection of life): 1) It's illegal. This bill violates the state constitution and also violates the federal Hyde-Weldon Amendment, putting at risk \$6 billion per year of federal funding for health and welfare programs in our state. With the current budget deficit, we cannot afford to lose this funding. 2) It's unnecessary. People who wish to obtain insurance coverage for abortions can already do so. 3) The conscience provisions in this bill are ineffective. Individuals and service organizations - essentially anyone other than churches themselves – are left without protection and will be forced to violate their conscience. This is an egregious assault on religious liberty.

Once again, I urge you to disseminate this information to your council members, family and friends to contact their state senator in opposition to HB2330. We can do this!
