Dilexit nos ENCYCLICAL LETTER OF THE HOLY FATHER FRANCIS ON THE HUMAN AND DIVINE LOVE OF THE HEART OF JESUS CHRIST



On 24 October 2024, Pope Francis published the encyclical Dilexit nos, dedicated to the Sacred Heart. In it, he calls for a renewed understanding of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in modern times and in the face of the many urgent challenges that they present. The document places emphasis on personal spirituality and community missionary commitment. It is the first papal encyclical dedicated to the Sacred Heart since Pope Pius XII's 1956 encyclical Haurietis Aquas. **FS** Notes

Dilexit nos (He loved us) is the fourth encyclical of Pope Francis, subtitled "On the human and divine love of the Heart of Jesus Christ". Similar to previous encyclicals, in Dilexit nos Pope Francis criticizes modern phenomena, such as individualism, social and economic disparities, and "uses of technology that threaten our humanity", and calls for rediscovery of "heart" as a way towards unity, peace, and reconciliation in the modern era.

We have opportunities to show our devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus at the Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament each first and third Friday of the month at St. Vincent's from 10am to 10pm, and the second and fourth Fridays of the month at St. Theresa's from 9:30am to 9:30pm. These are opportunities that too few Knights of our council take advantage of. Jesus in the Garden of Olives asked his apostles, "Could you not keep watch for an hour?" (Mk 14:41). In the same way, Jesus must surely ask of us, "Can you not pray for one hour with me?"
